



## **Patient Safety Checklist**

If you require surgery to remove your gallbladder also known as a Laparoscopic Cholecystectomy, *Print this and bring it to your surgical consultation.*

### **Part 1: Technology & Equipment**

- Does this facility have Near-Infrared (NIR) imaging capabilities?
- Will you be using **ICG-Fluorescence Imaging** (Green Light) during my procedure?
- If ICG is used, will it be administered at least 45 minutes prior to surgery?

### **Part 2: Surgical Protocol**

- Do you strictly adhere to the "Critical View of Safety" (CVS)?
- What is your "Bailout" plan if the anatomy is hidden by inflammation? (e.g., Subtotal cholecystectomy or ICG use).

### **Part 3: Post-Op Vigilance**

- Who is my 24/7 contact if I experience jaundice, fever, or extreme pain?
- If a complication is suspected, will you order a HIDA scan or MRCP immediately? (Most BDI is diagnosed *after* discharge).
